Since its first issue, *SHELBYANA* has continued a wide variety of Shelby County genealogical material. Starting with the earliest recorded in the county, will abstracts, guardianships, and newspaper items have been published chronologically and in current issues.

Some of the many additional items included for genealogists have been naturalizations, births, deaths, burials, marriages, court records, Bible records, and other family information. Each issue contains a surname index for easy reference.

Subscriptions to *SHELBYANA* are included automatically with membership in the Shelby County Genealogical Society, and include unlimited free queries (research question or specific help request from other members and readers). Please attach your query to this form.
